Before India's independence, Basavakalyan was called Kalyani. After independence and division of states on linguistic basis in 1956, Kalyana was renamed as BasavaKalyan in memory of VishwaguruBasavanna, a social reformer who established AnubhavaMantapa (spiritual democracy)

in 12th-century India. Basavakalyan was ruled by Western Chalukyas, Kalachuris of Kalyani, Yadavas of Devagiri, Kakatiyas, Delhi Sultanate, BahamaniSultanate, Mughals and Hyderabad Nizams. S.S.K. Basaveshwaf Arts, Science, Commerce, UG & PG College, was started in 1967. This Institution is one of the earliest Colleges in Basavakalyan.
